Delinquent members for 2023-24 were dropped ef-


fective March 31, 2024. If you do not plan on renewing your dues for 2024-2025, please call the office at 937-325-4848.

The dress code for the golf course will go into effect April 1. Proper golf attire will be required and enforced.




