Below is a partial list of items that are wanted:

Sunblock, socks, underwear, flip-flops, ChapStick, baby wipes, soap (shampoo, body wash, face wash, etc.), toothpaste, toothbrush and floss, deodorant (travel size/nonaerosol), batteries (AAs and AAs), pencils, hand sanitizer, pain-relieving topical cream, hand warmers, sewing kits, lens cleaning cloths and powder.

When it comes to food,


